These are **NOVICE** events for horse / pony and rider combinations **NOT** to have been placed first in a similar competition.

Entry Fee: £5.00 per class

Sashes sponsored by Helen & Nick Caton

Class 1: Best Turned Out Pony & Rider - 10.00am

To be judged in two age groups if sufficient entries.

Class 2: Best Family Pony / Horse (under 15hh)

Competitors any age. To include a small jump.

To be judged on suitability and turnout.

Class 3: Best Rider

To be split into lead rein and non lead rein. Will be judged in two age groups if sufficient entries.

Starting at approximately 2pm;

Class 5: Gymkhana (kindly organised by Joan & Colin Bomford)

Entry Fees: £2 per race or £6 per section

To follow showing classes at approximately 2pm

Championship rosette awarded to competitor gaining most points in each section.

Horse / pony and rider combinations **NOT** to have been placed first in a similar competition.

Class 6: Competitors 10 years & under on lead rein / assisted

Jumps not to exceed 40cm in first round

Class 7: Competitors 12 years & under

Jumps not to exceed 50cm in first round

Class 8: Competitors 14 years & under

Jumps not to exceed 60cm in first round

Class 9: Competitors - OPEN

Jumps not to exceed 70cm in first round

Class 10: Competitors - OPEN

Jumps not to exceed 80cm in first round

Clear Round Handy Pony

10.30am to 12pm & when Fancy Dress finishes until 4pm

Entry Fee: £2.50 per round

Rosettes awarded for FAULTLESS rounds.

To start at 12pm

Class 4: Fancy Dress - Entry Fee: £3.00

Mounted or un-mounted for children of any age.

Clear Round Show Jumping - 10.30am to 4pm - Entry Fee: £3.00 per round

Rosettes awarded for all clear rounds.

Rules;

Hard hats with fastened chin straps to current BHS and Pony Club recognised standards (PAS 015, VG1 + kite mark) and riding boots must be worn at all times when mounted (no trainers).

Spurs and whips will not be allowed in Gymkhana games.

Each competitor must carry their own liability insurance.

Peopleton Village Recreation Trust accepts no liabilities for any damage, accident, illness or injury to horses / ponies, riders, spectators or any other persons or property on the ground. All cars, trailers, lorries, and horseboxes are parked at owner's risk.

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents and prevent them occurring and must obey instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the schedule on the day as deemed necessary.

Ages of competitors are as on day of show.

The judges decision will be final. Any objections or protests must be handed in to the secretary's box in writing within half an hour of the incident together with a £20 deposit which is non-refundable if the objection is not upheld.

Dogs must be on leads at **ALL** times.

The committee reserves the right to ask anybody to leave the showground.
